\$1 MILLION MATCH

Chancellor's Alumni Council Scholarships Matching Fund

» Every dollar donated to the following alumni scholarship funds will be **matched 1:1 up to a maximum of \$1 million** combined for all funds. With this matching gift, UC San Diego will amplify support for new generations of explorers across California's diverse communities.

» The Chancellor's match of \$1 for each \$1 donated to the alumni council scholarship endowment funds applies to any donations in any amount for a period of up to five years, as long as it follows a written pledge sign on or before June 30, 2024.

» The Chancellor's match will remain open until June 30, 2024, or until the designated funds are exhausted, whichever comes first.
