UC San Diego has always pursued new discoveries and breakthroughs with the potential to improve health. Since 1966, when we assumed the lease of the former County Hospital and began operating what is now known as UC San Diego Medical Center — Hillcrest, we've focused our strengths in innovation and outside-of-the-box thinking on the health and well-being of our community.

In 1968, UC San Diego School of Medicine graduated its first class of 48 students — physician-scientists who received a revolutionary, hands-on education — and ever since, we've been finding new ways to bring fresh insights and nonconventional ideas to the way we think about health care and education. And that approach has paid off.
