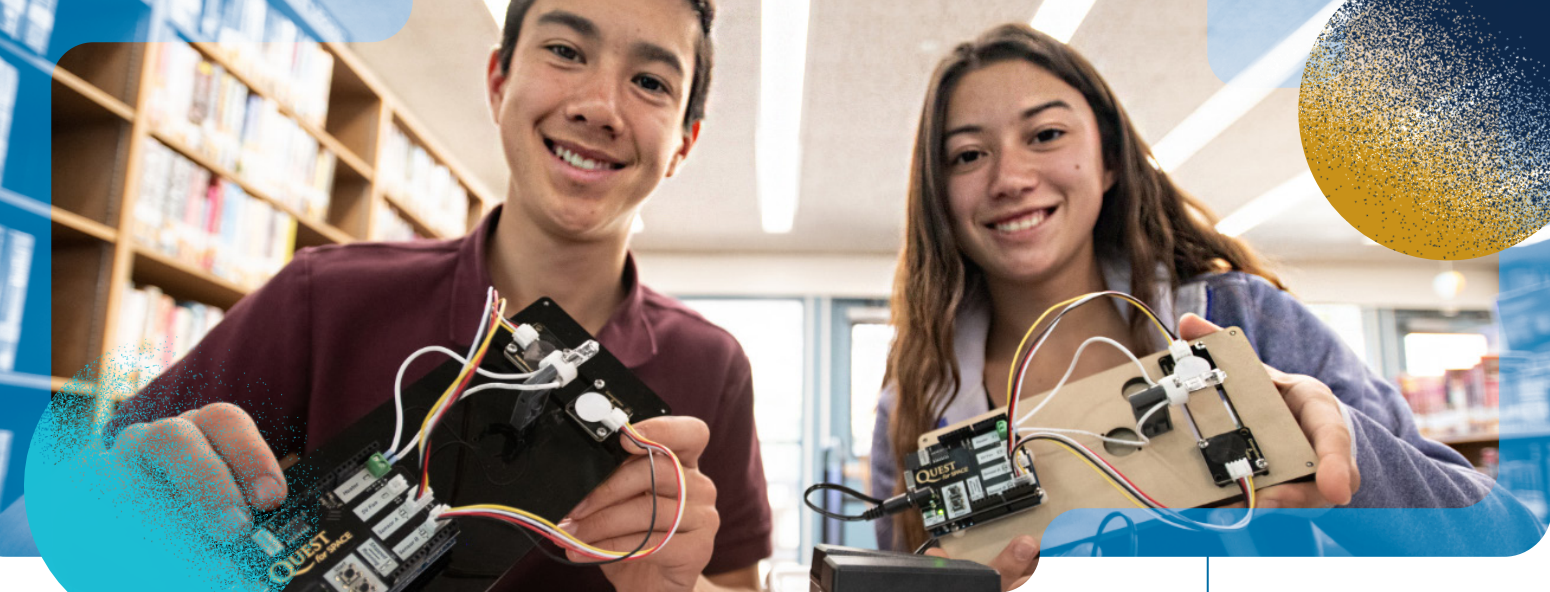

SALLY RIDE SCIENCE

Sally Ride was America's first woman in space. After she retired from NASA, she taught physics at UC San Diego and decided to use her famous name to advance a cause she cared about. Over the years, Sally Ride Science created acclaimed STEM programs for youth of all backgrounds across the country. In 2015, Sally Ride Science found a new home as a nonprofit based at UC San Diego under the direction of the Division of Extended Studies. Today, Sally Ride Science continues Ride's legacy with innovative programs encouraging diversity in STEAM (STEM plus arts).
