Creating access to success

At UC San Diego, our students are anything but ordinary. They are among the highest achievers in their communities, demonstrably capable of great things. And we are committed to ensuring that every qualified, admitted student has access to the resources they need to succeed at UC San Diego and beyond.

The UC San Diego Summer Bridge Program is designed to engage students and support their successful transition to college life. Our student-centered five-week summer program immerses first-year students in UC San Diego the summer before their first quarter. Students enroll in classes, receive the support of a peer mentor, access academic support resources, gain a sense of belonging, and participate in social events that enrich their experiences in the classroom, with their peers, and across our campus.

Summer Bridge focuses on making sure our students have the tools they need to hit the ground running. Our program introduces students to UC San Diego's academic culture and helps them build a robust supportive community, develop a network of peers and mentors, and transition from high school to college.
