With our new Triton Center complex, **UC San Diego is launching Student First Stop, an innovative resource hub designed to assist students in navigating our full spectrum of resources**. As our student population continues to grow, our campus adds highly effective programs that meet students where they're at — as individuals and as members of vibrant, intersecting communities. Student First Stop empowers students to set their path to success, however they define it.

While students may learn about programs relevant to their experience during orientation, it's easy for specifics to get lost. The challenge is even greater for those of our students encountering a large, complex institution like UC San Diego for the first time. **Student First Stop clears the way, so students can focus on what matters most.** Connecting to programs like the Triton Transfer Hub, the Student Veterans Resource Center and the Career Center optimizes student opportunity.

To meet students where they're at, Student First Stop will be more than a single, transactional help desk. Students can connect through a chat bot, approach Student First Stop student ambassadors at a tent traveling to campus events like Homecoming and career fairs, or visit the headquarters in the Triton Administrative Services Building. Each node for connection prioritizes clear guidance over a quick transaction, ensuring that students understand how to access services after their visit.

Student First Stop ambassadors are student employees, trained to be familiar with which programs are the best matches for particular needs, and how individual students can access them. Peer-to-peer support offers significant benefits, including connecting individuals with shared experiences and fostering a sense of belonging. Students who are veterans, international students, transfers, aspiring entrepreneurs and researchers — all types of experience are enhanced by involvement in similarly interested communities, with similar constellations of aspiration. Our students set goals in countless directions. With Student First Stop, we're giving them the tools to navigate the way.
