Herbert Wertheim School of Public Health and Human Longevity Science at UC San Diego was established in September 2019 to leverage the university's existing research strengths and build on a rich history of public health and preventive medicine to advance well-being and social justice for all.

The founding of the Herbert Wertheim School of Public Health also elevates the university's public health curriculum, as it cultivates the next generation of diverse public health professionals and leaders through seven innovative and transformational degree programs and seven strategic research priorities.

By transcending the traditional boundaries of academia, the school connects innovative education, leading research and community experts to address challenges through impactful projects and hands-on learning experiences.

The bachelor's program lays the groundwork for education about 21st century public health challenges and knowledge that is extended in the master's programs. The school also offers doctoral training in biostatistics, epidemiology, global health and health behavior — with a soon-to-be-initiated program in health services research and implementation science — while the nationally acclaimed General Preventive Medicine Residency program provides a unique program for postgraduates and a strength for the school.

At UC San Diego, we believe that what we don't know today will forever change our tomorrows. Empowered by generosity and fueled by curiosity, we are unafraid to chase the unknown — to ask the questions no one has asked before and to push the boundaries of possibility. 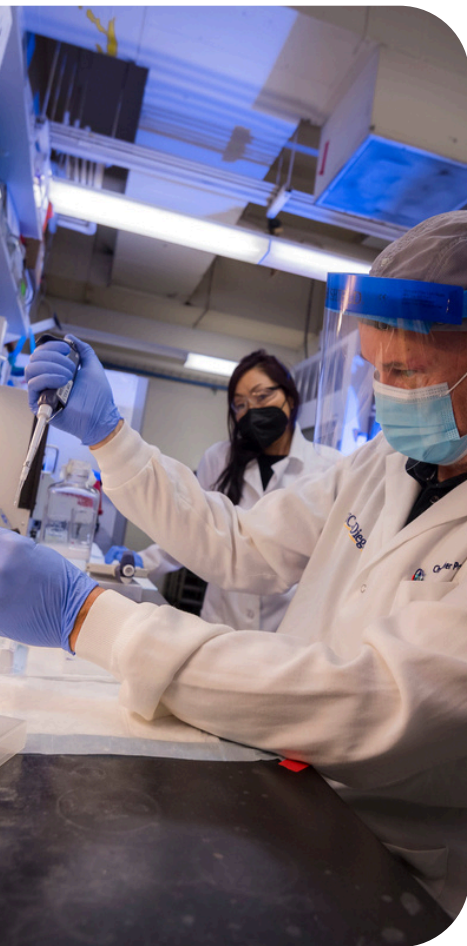
